**Instruction #2, Recommendation:** letters for HS Seniors can be from *High School* advisors or instructors.

**Instruction #8:** Submit a copy of letter of acceptance for your chosen program, or detailed explanation if this is not possible by this deadline.

- 5) Return completed application *prior* to **deadline April 30, 2011** for King-Pierce County consideration, and June 10 for state scholarship consideration.
